OUTREACH OPPORTUNITIES

THREE MAJOR MINISTRY OPPORTUNITIES ARE NOW IN THE FOREFRONT OF OUR PRAYERS AT WORLD CHRISTIAN OUTREACH. WE HAVE BEEN PRAYING FOR THESE OUTREACHES AND WE FEEL THAT NOW IS THE TIME TO BRING THEM TO YOUR ATTENTION AND LAUNCH THEM.

#1 – OPPORTUNITY FOR GRADUATION

Our Seniors at New Dawn High School are approaching the end of their 4th year. The way it works in Kenya is that every graduating Senior (Form 4) takes what is equivalent to our College Entrance Exam on the same day at the same time in November. Depending on how each student does on this test, opportunities may be available to them through the government to go on and pursue the vocation of their choice at a University.

Almost every student is different in their career desires; but, all have financial needs as they launch out into the field of their choice. Some may want to start their own small business... another told me that he wants to be a judge...one of the top academic girls in the school wants to be a doctor...another young man wants to work in auto mechanics...and another wants to be a Pastor.

We are now setting up a separate Graduation Fund to be administered by the In Country Board of WCO in Kenya to help these graduates. As funds accumulate here we will wire them to James Kariuki for distribution as their Board decides. It is our desire to raise an average of \$500 per student (or \$12,500 for the 25 students) which will be used to assist our needy orphaned kids. If we can raise more, Praise The Lord, because every one of our kids are so special! This will be an annual tradition to help our graduating students.

One other thing – New Dawn High School is to be run as they do things in Kenya. There – graduation from High School is not a ceremonial big thing as it is from University. In fact it is hardly recognized as an event. Rather than spend thousands of dollars in air fares to go from America for a “graduation exercise” that is almost nonexistent, it is better to take that money and give it directly to the Graduation Fund for better use to help our students.

Please help us launch this important Graduation Fund and please mark your gift accordingly if God is speaking to you about helping in this area. Many of our sponsors have indicated a desire to give more than the monthly for their student. This is the most important thing that we can do at this time to help our graduating students.

#2 – NEW DAWN CHOIR TO AMERICA

One of the great blessings we receive every time that we go to New Dawn Community is to see and hear the different classes sing and perform. What a tremendous blessing they have been to all! When the kids get up and sing, something almost magical takes over; and we know that it is The Holy Spirit moving, energizing, quickening, and using their God given talents and giftings. Within the student body, leaders have emerged, and different groups have formed – again, led by The Holy Spirit.

Our desire is to bring to California a singing and performing group of 15 from our New Dawn students to represent what has taken place at New Dawn in Laikipia, Kenya. What better way to present the ministry here than to see and hear from our own kids. We know how to do it! We know how to make all of the arrangements because we have done it twice already with The African Children's Choir at a local church. We have many churches that are ready to receive them. James Kariuki is already making preparations in Kenya to obtain Passports and Visas for the selected kids.

Again, it is a matter of prayer, preparation, organization, and finances. The main cost of this venture will be the up-front expenditures for round trip air fares for the kids, leaders, and chaperones; costs for Passports and Visas in Kenya; and then transportation within the U.S. We will take offerings as they perform.

Now, this is very exciting! It can and will happen with your help! The total cost for each student to come is \$3,500. This covers everything! Maybe you would like to be the financial leader for one of these students – to raise the funds for one New Dawn Choir student from your friends and family. Or, maybe you could talk to your church leaders and have a church sponsor one of these kids. Maybe you could have a garage sale, special picnic, or event to raise the funds. The opportunities are endless!

Please pray about this and see what God would have you to do. We plan to bring the kids here for 4-6 weeks in 2010. All arrangements will have to be made well in advance, so please let us know what you may want to do.

#3 - WHAT MAKES A NATION GREAT

During our recent ministry trip to Kenya I had the opportunity to talk with Mr. Mark Luce, a team member, and representative from Grace Community Church in Napa, CA. Mark is a retired executive from Chevron Oil and presently serves as Chairman of The Board of Supervisors of Napa County. This was his second ministry trip to Africa with WCO.

Mark is highly motivated to be used by God to help bring nations to Jesus Christ. The subjects of his messages on this trip were – “We Are Ambassadors Of An Eternal Kingdom” and “Courageous Love”. On the first trip Mark spoke on “What Makes A Nation Great”. As we talked together in Africa it became very clear to me that WCO can bring together political,

business, and Pastoral leaders from around the country of Kenya to meet in the capital city of Nairobi for a Conference on "What Makes A Nation Great". Mark and I team up in these presentations and somehow the Lord Jesus Christ blesses what we do in a great way.

At this time we have excellent relationships with about 4000 Pastors throughout East Africa. Many of our contacts are Bishops and Church Leaders. These men in turn have contacts with business people and politicians ranging up to the Vice President of the country, who is a Christian. We want to bring them together in a Conference setting at a hotel or The Kenyatta Conference Center in May of 2010. I have spoken to James Kariuki our African Director about this and he is ready to put it together.

As always it takes prayer, planning, organization, and money. Here at WCO we believe that money follows ministry. We have been reaching out to the rural Pastors and churches of East Africa with preaching, teaching, and healing in accordance with Matthew 4:23 for the past 9 years without ever taking offerings. We are ready to do the same again for this event. But money will be needed.

James has informed us that it will take between \$15,000 - \$20,000 to put this all together. This includes invitations, venue costs, food, transport for choirs and some attendees, hotel expense, and media coverage. Our aim is to conduct two main conference sessions – one for the business and political communities, and one for Pastors, elders, and church leaders. We can make a great impact for Jesus Christ with these two conferences on the nation of Kenya. In December of 2007 the country was almost torn apart and destroyed from election and tribal wars. Underneath the apparent calm now in place there is still a real, underlying simmering of unrest. The country needs healing. Our intent is to aim at the leaders and we can do it with the existing contacts that we have in place.

We need your prayers and, yes...we need your extra financial help as soon as possible to make this happen!
