

## **OUTREACH TO AFRICA**

**On February 6<sup>th</sup> I will be departing from Los Angeles flying on Turkish Airways through Istanbul arriving in Nairobi, Kenya at 0325am on the 8<sup>th</sup>. At the same time Evangelist Sohail Peter will be departing Lahore, Pakistan bound for Nairobi as well as Vincent Sangalo from Kampala, Uganda and a representative from Tanzania coming across their borders to Kenya's capital city.**

**We are coming together for a significant Conference on The African Covenant, meeting with Pastors and Leaders from Kenya. We all will review the statement by Ugandan President Yoweri Museveni of personal and national repentance of sin and hear from Pastor Sangalo on how he was able to get 2 million signatures of Christian Unity, Oneness, and Agreement that was presented to the Uganda Parliament.**

**Pastor Steven Mshomi in Tanzania is now working on the project there and is very encouraged by the unity of the brethren throughout his country. Evangelist Peter will be sharing the tremendous challenges and persecution that he and other Christians are facing in Pakistan.**

**World Christian Outreach believes in moving out from strength in the Spirit to manifesting itself in action by following Matthew 4:23 – “And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and disease among the people.” This is possible because Jesus, himself, stated before He gave us the Great Commission that “All power is given unto me in heaven and in earth....Go ye, therefore,...” Matthew 28:18,19a.**

These ministry trips cost money with air fares, food, lodging, and conference expenses; but they are very vital to the brethren involved. ## **ACTIVITIES AT NEW DAWN**

- 1. We were able to send \$2600 to our teachers and staff for Christmas bonuses. They are so thankful for what you have done. Thank you, Jesus!**
- 2. James Kariuki, our Director, reports that they have completed the harvesting of corn on 82 acres of land. I will receive the full report during my upcoming trip.**
- 3. Construction is proceeding very well with the building of 3 new Greenhouses of which 2 have been completed. This was the focus of our Senior Legacy project for the year. The students take great pride in what they accomplish. Previous years projects have included the basketball court, the prayer and meeting gazebo in the center of the courtyard, and the prayer garden. Pastor Ron Sukut will be going next July with a group to build a commercial poultry farm at New Dawn.**
- 4. Every year we purchase the National Exams for the seniors to complete which enables them to graduate and possibly go on to University. This has been accomplished.**
- 5. We will be holding a Graduation for 2 of our classes on February 15<sup>th</sup> while I am at New Dawn. Dignitaries will be coming in from around the country for this wonderful event.**
- 6. We will be receiving an intake of 24 new students on February 6<sup>th</sup>. We are still receiving funds for their uniforms, books, and school supplies.**
- 7. 3 more large milk producing cows have been purchased. Praise the Lord!**
