Dear Friends of the Ministry –

Greetings and good cheer to you in the New Year of 2018! With the New Year upon us, new ministry developments are taking place within WCO that I want to inform you about.

World Christian Outreach has expanded and will now focus primarily on evangelistic outreach, supplying much needed medical helps to the needy in East Africa, providing clear clean water to the community, supplying food for the hungry and needy, conducting Pastors and leaders conferences throughout East Africa, encouraging prayer support for the nations, and continuing to help with much needed “tools of ministry” such as providing PA Systems, supplying Bibles, building churches, eyeglasses, etc., etc. as needs arise.

Our International Farm in Bahati, Kenya is presently producing foodstuffs to supply needed food especially during times of drought. We drilled and hit water there which is now helping to serve the community. In addition, my wife, Damaris, is putting together a Medical Outreach Team to Kenya next year as a prelude to establishing lasting Medical Clinics in Africa. You can help a person once medically, just like you can feed them once; but the real valuable help is to bring them into a Medical Clinic for follow up to make sure they are treated properly.

In the past week 2000 prayer warriors were praying in Rwanda for the nations. Kenya is developing as a major economic/technological hub for commerce in East Africa and has always been a lighthouse for God to the nations of Africa. We are moving to develop a “cross fertilization in the Spirit” between East Africa, Europe and Pakistan. Our next Leaders Conference in Tanzania in July will bring together Pastor Eduardo Fernandes of the Riverside International Church in Cascais, Portugal; Evangelist Sohail Peter from Lahore, Pakistan; Pastor-Evangelist Daniel Kitheka from Kenya/USA; and myself as coordinator. We are also praying to impact the Youth of the cities where we will be ministering.

To follow up our Church building activities in Kenya, we were able to purchase a complete PA System and keyboard to be jointly used by the different denominational churches in Molo, Kenya. Also, we have been able to carry forth food distribution to the needy in Kenya, given out by the churches. Our last shipment of food was 63 bags of potatoes, 25 bags of cabbage, and 12 bags of corn. All of our ministry activities follow the example of Jesus from Matthew 4:23 and 9:35 – “And Jesus went about all Galilee, teaching in their synagogues, preaching the Gospel of the kingdom, and healing all manner of sickness and all manner of disease among the people”.

Thank you for all of your prayers and support as we embark upon new vistas of opportunities to advance the Kingdom of God in 2018. “If God be for us, who can be against us!” - Romans 8:31.
