The group will be ministering in rural churches primarily in Molo and Nakuru, Kenya then going to Laikipia for a Regional Pastors and Leaders Conference. While in Laikipia they will also be ministering to and meeting up with our 25 high school orphans at New Dawn Community.

The theme for the Regional Conference is Proverbs 4:18 – “The path of the righteous is like the first gleam of dawn, shining ever brighter till the full light of day”. Kenya is a lighthouse shining the goodness and blessings of God throughout their own country and into East Africa and the whole continent. We believe that Africa, once referred to as the “dark continent” is transforming their own culture from the terrible ravages of corruption, poverty, disease and illiteracy by the proclamation of the Gospel and the power of personal testimony of individual Christians.
